


From the Committee of Nominations Chair

In 2024 of Living the Kin-dom, we will deepen our study to include the ways Jesus preached and ministered a proximity to the kin-dom. Jesus said those inheriting the coming and future kingdom were those typically pushed outside the hierarchies of belonging – the hungry, the stranger, and the prisoner (Matt 25:40). Not only would they inherit the kingdom, but to enter the kingdom we have to become like children (Matt 18:1-5), be more righteous than a Pharisee (Matt 5:20) or be poor in spirit (Matt 5:3). Furthermore, the Lord's prayer speaks well to the second year of the curricula when we will be exploring the proximity of the kinddom. This second study will focus on the invitation to posture our lives and transform ourselves in ways that bring us proximity to the kin-dom and the kindom in proximity to us.
