We have a lot of things planned and would like to share them with you:

1. UMCOR Shoebox program. We have 25 shoe boxes to fill and ship.

2. Women Are Safe - They need purse size hand sanitizer, household cleaning products, disinfectant wipes (if we can find them), and Lysol spray.

3. Adopt-A-Class - Because of restrictions due to COVID, we cannot visit the class. We have sent a text to the teacher to see if she has any needs for her class that we can help with.

4. **Centerville Life Care Center** - Because of COVID, we cannot have the annual birthday party that we normally host in August. The activity director has told me that we can send a card and gift to each of the August birthday people. There are 7 of them, all ladies. She has given me suggestions of items that they would like. We can put together the gifts along with a card and take them to the center.

5. **East Hickman High School** - The school needs items for their hygiene closet along with grab and go snacks. Specifically they need shampoo, body wash, deodorant, toothbrushes, tooth paste, and laundry detergent. The laundry detergent is for kids who shower and wash their clothes at school. We'll also get snacks for them.

6. Hickman County High School – One of the teachers is checking to see what is needed.
